

What is going on now (as of March 2, 2023)?

1. Us and our national co-counsel Motley Rice (<https://www.motleyrice.com/transportation/train-crash-lawsuits>) are in the process of gathering the best available experts who will assist us in testing and medical issues for all affected persons. We are trying to balance the immediate needs with the concerns that rushing things in this area can sometimes be a mistake. We will update our client based on all of these developments as they occur.
2. We have filed 2 “class action” lawsuits against NS. The first is what is called a “medical monitoring” class action, which seeks to have NS indefinitely pay for medical monitoring of folks who are experiencing obvious medical issues associated with exposure to the toxins from the train. The second is a “economic” type of class action, which seeks to have NS pay for all of the economic loss experienced by the folks affected by the train derailment, including loss of property value, loss of income or revenue, and the costs associated with testing and cleaning of the residential and business properties and business operations in the affected areas.
3. We also will pursue individual claims for all medical and bodily personal injury for all of our affected clients. This will allow us to concentrate on our clients’ individual and specific losses associated with the toxic exposure. Our clients are sending us regular updates on their frustrating attempts to get medical testing and treatment for their numerous medical ailments associated with the toxic exposure, including breathing issues, intestinal issues, sever headaches, fatigue and brain fog and general malaise.
